

## Supporters Raise \$184,605 During “Power of Peace” Appeal

Contributors showed enormous support for The Prem Rawat Foundation (TPRF) during the “Power of Peace Appeal,” raising US \$184,605 to help ensure that initiatives like the [Peace Education Program](#) and [Food for People](#) reach even more people in 2018 and beyond.

The appeal took place throughout December and featured four new videos that highlight how contributions to TPRF make a remarkable difference in people’s lives. Nearly 900 donors participated in the effort, including several especially generous backers who provided \$57,000 in matching funds.
